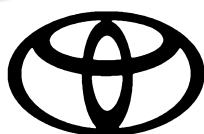

The program goal is to implement a long-term monitoring program of Inuvialuit harvest-based wildlife and related environmental observations.

Reporting to the Executive Director of the Joint Secretariat, the Coordinator will design, plan and manage the operational delivery of CBM functions, coordinate ongoing initiatives, and support monitoring activities of the 6 ISR communities. Activities are primarily in office; however, travel will be required both within and outside of the ISR.

The qualified applicant should possess a university or technical degree in a relevant field or an equivalent level of experience. The individual should be well organized, experienced in program or project management, exhibit tact and good judgement and be capable of forming and leading successful teams in program operations at the community level in remote areas. Familiarity with the structure and functions of the Inuvialuit Final Agreement, its various organizations and resulting responsibilities is an asset. Rezoning Application
Lots 2-7 and Lot 12, 24094 LTO
in the Louise Lake area

The Yukon government is proposing to amend the Whitehorse Periphery Development Area Regulations (O.I.C. 2013/207) as follows:

- to amend the regulation to allow existing non-conforming lots to be enlarged through either subdivision or consolidation with an existing parcel, to less than the minimum lot size; and
- to allow a zoning designation boundary to follow a new or existing parcel boundary when a survey is registered at the Land Titles Office for an approved lot enlargement or lot consolidation.

The proposed amendment is required to facilitate lot enlargements and consolidations for Lots 2-7 and Lot 12, 24094 LTO in the Louise Lake area.

The amendment will also make the regulation consistent with other development area (zoning) regulations by allowing future lot enlargements to be processed without the need for rezoning and to allow lot enlargements that are less than the minimum parcel size of 6 ha.

Written comments on the proposed rezoning will be accepted until **May 25, 2016**.

1901 News from the Whitehorse Star

A Freak Snowslide

Everybody in this section of Yukon Territory and in Posey County, Missouri, knows Mr. J.P. Whitney of Whitney & Pedlar. (He always says, "You'll have to show me!") Mr. Whitney has ever been up-to-date in his efforts to make White Horse a modern city with fire-proof buildings, wider streets and plenty of sidewalks. Last November he conceived the idea of adding an extra chimney to his big building and, regardless of freezing weather, engaged a man to do the work. The chimney was built in symmetrical form but, owing to the fact that the weather was not propitious, the mortar failed to stick to the bricks, and become frigid and wholly at home with itself.

Previous to the building of the chimney Mr. Whitney had dug a well on the side of the building where the new

chimney was erected and this was covered over with boards.

Last Monday ended the checkered career of the new chimney. A large mass of snow had accumulated behind the smoke avenue and on that day decided to move to terra firma. On its way down it picked up the chimney and the whole landed on top of the covering over the well. The boards were light and snow, bricks and mortar went through to the bottom, nothing remaining except the cavity through which it all passed.

Mr. Whitney will rebuild his chimney, but he will not do it in cold weather, and is now giving out the story that he has the only well in the Yukon Territory with a chimney in it.
