*1962 News from the Whitehorse Star***Liquor Tackled**

Much publicity has been given lately
 in speeches, addresses, open letters and
 finally in Council to the Alcohol and
 related Health & Welfare problems.
 We have learned from the Chief Med-
 ical Health Officer that a snow-balling
 lion's share of welfare expenditures, as
 well as Public Health and Indian
 Health Services costs are the direct
 consequence of uncontrolled Alco-
 holism.

The Commissioner emphasized in his
 opening address to Council the urgent
 need for action to ensure better control
 of the situation but differed widely as
 to the priority and timing of such ac-
 tion. The entire issue may be tabled for
 some time and nothing done now de-
 spite the build-up over the last year.

If the claims of the Public Health and
 Welfare offices are true, and anyone
 with open eyes does not need to study
 the statistical evidence to know the
 truth of it, then council must ask itself:
 What other business can be more im-
 portant than to tackle this over-riding
 problem - Alcoholism and its destruc-
 tive effects?

In an interview with Dr. O. Schaefer,
 who, with his relentless campaign
 since fall of 1960 in public and private

talks, articles and interviews, has prop-
 agated a growing awareness of the in-
 terrelated problems of Alcoholism,
 social degradation, diseases and delin-
 quency, we asked him to outline again
 a practical Alcohol control system,
 which he first proposed last year in a
 talk given to the Alcoholics Anony-
 mous Association.

TOP HOSPITAL RATE

Dr. Schaefer shared his remarks with
 a citation from a 1959 publication ac-
 cording to which Alcoholism, with
 well over 200,000 victims in Canada,
 is the nation's 4th greatest health prob-
 lem, outranked only by mental dis-
 eases, cardiovascular diseases and
 cancer. He pointed out: "In the Yukon
 Territory, however, Alcoholism is by
 far the greatest health problem, out-
 ranking every one of the other three.
 This reflects on the higher hospitaliza-
 tion rate of the Yukon Territory - the
 highest in Canada - the more remark-
 able as normally with out young popu-
 lation structure, we should have one of
 the lowest rates in Canada."
