The program goal is to implement a long-term monitoring program of Inuvialuit harvest-based wildlife and related environmental observations.

Reporting to the Executive Director of the Joint Secretariat, the Coordinator will design, plan and manage the operational delivery of CBM functions, coordinate ongoing initiatives, and support monitoring activities of the 6 ISR communities. Activities are primarily in office; however, travel will be required both within and outside of the ISR.

The qualified applicant should possess a university or technical degree in a relevant field or an equivalent level of experience.
