Bookkeeper

Under the general direction of the Director of Finance & Administration, this position is responsible for handling accounting practices, maintenance of fiscal records, and the preparation of financial reports including LSCFN's payroll and general monthly bank reconciliations. Answer routine enquiries, taking messages and other related duties as requested. Criminal Record Check, Term, full-time (1 year)

Utilities Manager

Reporting to the Capital Director, the Utilities Manager is responsible for the operation, monitoring and maintenance of water, sewage, mechanical, and electrical systems owned by the LSCFN and provides technical support to the Department of Capital Works in environmental related projects, and performs other related duties. High school graduation followed by several years' post-secondary education in water distribution, waste water collection and treatment systems. Certification in the operation of water distribution, water treatment and waste water treatment systems. Training and/or experience in staff supervision and general management. Permanent full-time.

Whitehorse Office Administrator

Reporting to the Executive Director, the Whitehorse Office Administrator is responsible for providing secretarial and administrative services in support of the LSCFN Government at the Whitehorse office. Organizing and scheduling meetings and other Committees as requested. Researching, compiling and prepare briefings on current issues identified by LSCFN Citizens residing within the Whitehorse area. Permanent full-time.

Heritage Assistant

Reporting to the Heritage Manager, the Heritage Assistant is responsible for assisting the Heritage Manager in establishing and maintaining the heritage section of the Land and Resource department. The position will research, archive and establish displays of heritage sites and artifacts of the LSCFN, work in partnership with LSCFN members and members of the Northern Tutchone Tribal Council to gather, verify and document the LSCFN heritage information, and perform other related duties. Term full-time, 6 months with a possibility of extension.

Lands and Resource Director

Reporting to the Executive Director, the incumbent is responsible for the overall planning, implementing and management of the Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation Lands & Resources Department. The position is responsible for implementing LSCFN rights and obligations related to land and resources within the Traditional Territory as directed through the Land Claims agreement. This is carried out by ensuring administration of all laws, regulations and policies related to use and occupation of Settlement Lands of the LSCFN; assisting the LSCFN Government in issues related to lands and resources; ensuring proper regulation and within the LSCFN Traditional Territory; and other related duties. Permanent full-time.

Implementation Assistant

Under the general direction of the Implementation Manager/Negotiator, this position is responsible for general administrative duties in the Implementation department. This position is required to research information on specific projects as directed by the supervisor attending meetings/negotiations as required; fill in when Implementation Manager is away; travel as required to attend various tables; other duties as required by Implementation Manager/Negotiator. 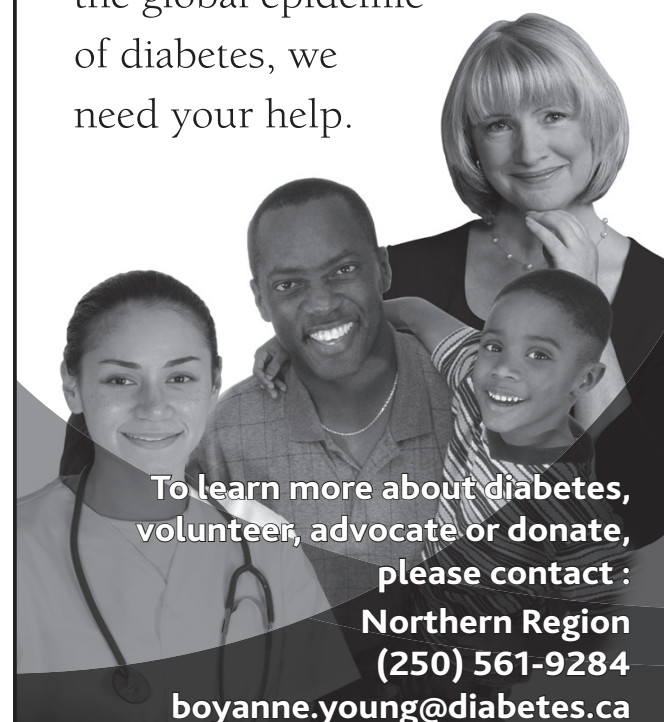
