



The "Short Man" Captured

Dawson, Feb. 28 - Wm. Brophy, the "short man" in the Dominion gambling house holdup which occurred here last fall, and for whom a reward of \$500 was offered, was captured last midnight at a roadhouse eight miles from Dawson on Bonanza Creek by four N.W.M.P.

He carried a rifle, but had no chance to use it as the police jumped on him from behind. In the scuffle that ensued Brophy was shot, but not dangerously. He was brought to Dawson and placed in jail this morning. All three men connected with the robbery (Tomelin, Harris, and Brophy) are now in custody.

Brophy held up a man on Bonanza four nights ago, robbing him of four ounces of gold dust, and it was from a description of the robber, given by the victim, that Brophy's whereabouts became known.
