Provost Marshal-General Leech wired from Washington, D.C. on February 21 to Mr. and Mrs. Murdock McCuish in Dawson, Y. T. informing them that their son John and his wife Virginia, had been released by the U.S. Forces from the Japanese internment camp at Santo Tomas, Luzon Island in the Philippines.

Mr. and Mrs. John McCuish were on Mindanao Island when the Japanese captured the Philippines and managed to evade capture for about two years by hiding in the hills before they were forced to surrender.
