Jade chunk may set world record Yukon find could be worth \$5.8 billion

Whitehorse Star, July 8, 1992

High on a snowy mountain top, some 145 kilometres north of Watson Lake, part of a large outcrop of rock gleams green - jade green.

This shining, embedded nugget is expected to set a new Guinness world record for the largest piece of nephrite jade.

It's been measured conservatively at 577 metric tonnes by Dennis Ouellette, a staff geologist with Northern Affairs in Whitehorse.

The current world record is held by China, where a 264tonne, or 291-Imperial ton, piece of jade was discovered in March, 1990....
