



The fence shall be fastened to the existing chain link fence of the Recycling Depot in an acceptable manner to prevent animals from entering.

The chainlink wire shall be grubbed in the ground 19" to discourage digging. This underground apron can be an extension of the fence or can be a separate section of fence attached to the fence and extended into the ground. 
