## A Freak Snowslide

Everybody in this section of Yukon Territory and in Posey County, Missouri, knows Mr. J.P. Whitney of Whitney & Pedlar. (He always says, "You'll have to show me!") Mr. Whitney has ever been up-to-date in his efforts to make White Horse a modern city with fire-proof buildings, wider streets and plenty of sidewalks. Last November he conceived the idea of adding an extra chimney to his big building and, regardless of freezing weather, engaged a man to do the work. The chimney was built in symmetrical form but, owing to the fact that the weather was not propitious, the mortar failed to stick to the bricks, and become frigid and wholly at home with itself.

Previous to the building of the chimney Mr. Whitney had dug a well on the

side of the building where the new chimney was erected and this was covered over with boards.

Last Monday ended the checkered career of the new chimney. A large mass of snow had accumulated behind the smoke avenue and on that day decided to move to terra firma. On its way down it picked up the chimney and the whole landed on top of the covering over the well. The boards were light and snow, bricks and mortar went through to the bottom, nothing remaining except the cavity through which it all passed.

Mr. Whitney will rebuild his chimney, but he will not do it in cold weather, and is now giving out the story that he has the only well in the Yukon Territory with a chimney in it.

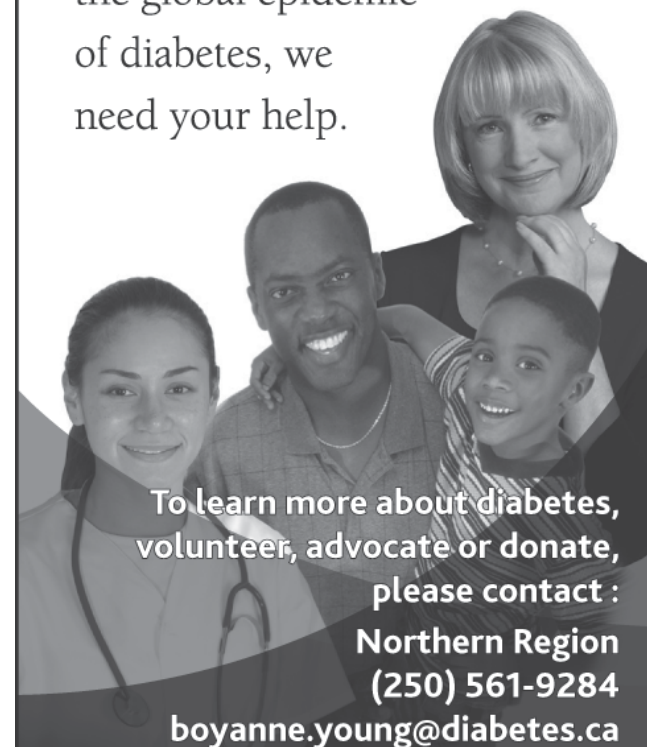

## Horses Need Winter Care Too!

Usually, horses can withstand a lot of cold, but they are not invincible. Making sure your horse gets the winter care he deserves can insure a healthy, happy horse all year round.

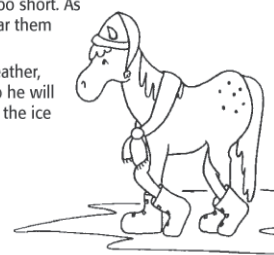
**FIRST**, make sure your horse gets annual vaccinations for rhinopneumonitis, Eastern and Western encephalomyelitis and tetanus. Get him checked for worms in the fall since he will have more energy if he is not playing host to a load of worms.

**NEXT**, be sure to have his teeth checked before winter so he can chew his food properly. This is a time he will need to burn more energy to stay warm, therefore increase his ration of hay.

**ALSO**, one of the most important things to check is that your horse has a clean, dry but well ventilated place to stay. A damp environment can lead to colds, coughs and viral infections. Poor ventilation can cause respiratory diseases while your horse can develop pneumonia if the stable is too hot or too tight. If you don't have a barn, your horse should at least have a three sided shelter, open on the down-wind side. Moist bedding can cause foot infection, so keep it dry.

**BESIDES THIS**, snow might be deep. Shoes should be pulled, because snow could ball up badly in shod hooves. This makes it difficult for your horse to walk. Trim the hooves enough so they won't crack or break, but not too short. As your horse paws through the snow, he will wear them down, causing sore hooves.

**REMEMBER**, if exercising your horse in cold weather, give him more time to warm up his muscles so he will be limber. And don't forget to break the ice in his water bucket or trough.
