The Dawson Hold-Up

Mat Tomerlin Confesses His Guilt and Implicates Brophy as His Partner in Crime

Dawson, Dec. 28 - Mat Tomerlin, who was held over on his preliminary hearing a few weeks ago on a charge of being one of the men that held up the Dominion gambling house here, on the 15th of last November, has made a full confession of his guilt, implicating William Brophy as the "short man," and

his partner in the crime. Immediately after the hold-up Brophy, who was suspicioned as being one of the robbers, was arrested and brought before the court, but on his preliminary examination the evidence was of such slight nature that he was dismissed.

Finding that Brophy could not be held on the charge of robbery another of vagrancy was entered against him, but this also failed, and about three weeks ago he was discharged from custody. He is now supposed to be concealed in some cabin either in this city or on one of the creeks. A reward has been offered for his apprehension. Tomerlin this morning accompanied the

police to where he had hidden his share of tne money amounting to \$700 and it was recovered. In extenuation of his crime, Tomerlin says

that just previous to its commission his wife had left him and being broke he was desperate and did not care what chances he took to secure money, but would have killed himself in the gambling room at the time of the hold-up rather than to have harmed any man there had there been any resistance offered.


