Call for Proposals to provide HEATING FUEL to the Village of Mayo

Fuel Delivery Companies are invited to provide a proposal to supply heating fuel to the Village of Mayo from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020.

Proposal must include either, or all, of the following Option A and/or B:

- **Option A)** A fixed price per liter for the duration of the contract; or
- **Option B)** A fixed discount on posted Mayo residential heating fuel rates (which may vary depending on market conditions).

Prices must be given for both Furnace Oil and Arctic Stove Oil.

(Note: the Village of Mayo's yearly use of Furnace and Stove Oil is approximately 80,000 liters).

Following are the terms of the contract:

1. The fuel supplier must be a registered business with the Village of Mayo and have his own liability insurance and Yukon workers compensation coverage. Any proposal received without a current Village of Mayo or Inter-Municipal business license may not be considered.
2. Fuel Oil must meet specifications as outlined under Section 3 - GP - 2D Type 1 and Section 3 - GP - 4P of the Canadian Government Specification Board.
3. The proposal must include all costs (including GST) and must remain valid and in effect for the duration of the contract, subject only to changes in Government taxes. The Clerk/Treasurer of the Village of Mayo must be advised immediately, in writing, of any price changes due to changes in taxation. If Option B is chosen, the Village of Mayo must be notified by fax or email prior to changes in fuel prices.
4. All applicable taxes are to be specified and included in the price.
5. The contractor must provide adequate, regularly scheduled delivery to tank locations (see list below). Fuel tanks, which are identified below, by the Village of Mayo must be topped up on a regular basis.

The land upon which the facility is situated, and the discharge occurs is MC509658 MC 510224 (legal description), 9 km south of the Yukon border off kilometer marker 1085 of the Alaska Highway, within the unincorporated Stikine regional district and Tootsee River watershed.

The proposed amendment requests a replacement of the conditions related to the existing fuel fired refuse incinerator, with an authorization for the operation of a new primary dual chamber containerized incinerator to be located at the old camp location at approximately [59.9338 N, 130.3459 W]. The amendment requests that the following conditions be changed from maximum authorized rate of refuse incineration from 300 kg/day to 680 kg/day.

The discharge rate and characteristics of air emissions from listed sources are described below:

- 1) The existing refuse incinerator will remain in its original location and will become the secondary incinerator with a new Eco Waste Solutions CSH_CA 600C incinerator becoming the primary incinerator. The primary incinerator will have a maximum discharge rate of 1.38 m3/s and emission characteristics as follows:
