C119 CRASH KILLS SEVEN MEN Search for Survivors Fruitless as all Airmen are Located by Investigators

Whitehorse Star, November 27, 1961

Seven men died in the crash of a United States Air Force C119 about thirty miles south of Whitehorse Thursday afternoon. Three men parachuted to safety and escaped with minor injuries from the sudden death that took their comrades.

It appears certain that the circumstances leading to the crash commenced on take off with something in the nature of a seized brake drum which ignited from the resultant heat. Apparently the plane was informed from the tower of the fire danger. Kasmaer Maczka, White pass and Yukon Route section foreman, watched the sequence of events that ended with the C119 slamming into the ground. Working at
