A CONSIGNMENT OF HOCKEY JUNK

It's not often a local hockey team has a chance to vie for the Stanley Cup, but it happened one time in Yukon history and the results of the contest make it probable that it will never happen again.

Hockey was big in the Klondike in 1904, and the competition so fierce that local promoters of the sport were looking for bigger and greater challenges. With the typical Yukon "if you're going to go for it, you might as well go for the top" attitude, Dawson organizers wrote to Ottawa challenging the World Champions to a Stanley Cup duel. The challenge was accepted.

The Klondike team sallied forth from Dawson to do battle with the Ottawa Invincibles, also known as "The Silver Seven."

Ottawa Hockey Team Won First Game of Series by Score of 9–2. The Dawson Hockey team went down in overwhelming defeat before the Ottawa Invincibles by a score of 23–2 in the second.
