## LIQUOR VOTE SET FOR JUNE 23

All Yukon residents, 19 years and up, will be asked to answer this question on Monday, June 23:

"Are you in favour of lowering the legal age for the consumption of alcoholic beverages from 21 years to 19 years of age?"

Commissioner James Smith announced the date and terms of the plebiscite this morning. It is believed to be the first time in Canada that underage voters will have had an opportunity to express their opinions on a question which directly affected them.

There will be no enumeration of voters, and no voters list compiled for the plebiscite, which will be conducted by Federal Returning Officer Harold J. MacDonald of Whitehorse. Instead, each voter will swear an affidavit that they are of the full age of 19 and they were ordinarily resident in the Yukon Territory on March 20, 1969. This was the date on which Yukon Territorial Council approved the idea of the plebiscite being held.

## DAWSON CRIMINAL RE-CAPTURED AFTER A YEAR'S HUNT

**SWAN HARRISON, AN INSANE PATIENT ARRESTED IN THE  
NORTHWEST TERRITORIES**

Swan Harrison, who escaped from the Northwest Mounted police at Selkirk on the Yukon a year ago, has just been captured by members of the same efficient force at a point thousands of miles distant. Harrison has been taken a prisoner in the Northwest territories.

A telegram has been received by Major Wood at Dawson telling him of the capture of Harrison.

When Harrison escaped at Selkirk he was being taken out of the Yukon to New Westminster, B.C. as an insane patient. He had been arrested and convicted at Dawson some time before for stealing, had become insane while in prison and was transferred to the lunatic ward.

While the steamer was lying at Selkirk Harrison made a leap from the boat, and landing partly in the water walked ashore, scrambled away up the bank and ran into the woods before he could be overtaken. He and a number of other lunatics were in charge of Corpl. Stewart on the trip up the river. A short search was made for Harrison, but he could not be found, and the boat proceeded with the remainder of the party.

From traces obtained it is believed he went down the Yukon river and escaped by way of St. Michael or Nome. He is said to be from the States, but how it is that he should wander over into the Northwest Territories is scarcely understood. It was thought at first from the point at which the fellow turned up he must have taken a chance at the famous Edmonton trail and gotten through, but the idea is scarcely credited.

The tender opening for the commercial lots and the lottery draw for the multi-family and townhouse lots will be held on **Tuesday, January 12.**

The lottery draw for the residential lots, including the duplex site and the country residential lots will be held on **Wednesday, January 13.**

## MOOSE CALF 'ADOPTS' MAN AS ITS MOTHER

Curt Mintz huddled in the bush with his two dogs for 20 minutes waiting for the cow moose to attack.

"There's no way you can come between a cow and a calf and live," Mintz said in an interview Monday. "I'd rather meet a grizzly."

But there was no attack.

Instead, Mintz became the adopted mother to a three-day-old female moose calf that now lives at the Yukon Game Farm on the Takhini Hot Springs Road.

Mintz came upon the moose on June 2 while strolling through the woods about four kilometres from his cabin on the Alaska Highway near Whitehorse.

"I heard it first, and I thought it was a bear, so I just dived down and grabbed the two dogs and held them."

"I knew whatever it was didn't hear me, 'cause it was making too much noise."

"When I saw it was calf sitting there, I was more worried. I thought, 'I came between a cow and a calf, I'm in really big trouble,' I stayed down there for about 20 minutes."

"I circled around the thing and saw it was a calf moose. So then I snuck up on it and within 10 feet, it heard me. It started crying just like a little baby."

That's when he realized it was alone.

The calf was probably a twin and left behind by its mother, Mintz said. If the mother had been shot, he said, the calf would have stayed with the mother and the hunters would have gotten it.

"It wouldn't have lasted overnight. There's no doubt about it. It's like Grand Central Station out there for coyotes."

He stroked the calf, grabbed it, put it on his shoulders and marched four kilometres back to his cabin with it.

"After about maybe an hour or two, it figured I was its mother. If I walked away from it, it would start crying."

The calf wasn't afraid of people, he said. It liked his dogs, his friend's cat, and gave his guests big moose-lip kisses.

It would cry to eat, lay down, and go outside because it wanted Mintz to be closer to it.

It was three days old, so it couldn't follow him far. It would walk for a while, then stop and cry when Mintz continued.

"I entertained thoughts at one point in time of keeping it," Mintz said. But he decided it would be better for the moose if it went to the game farm. Danny Nowlan, owner of the Yukon Game Farm, is an old friend of Mintz's father.

Nowlan has had a bull moose for about 10 years, said Mintz, and he hasn't be able to find a cow.

So, this could be the beginning of a Yukon moose family bred in captivity.

A Night’s Stampede

Monday’s stage from Dawson brought to White Horse the first news of a rich find of gold on a small creek below Selwin and about seven miles this side of Island Point road-house and running into the Yukon from the west bank.

The creek was prospected late last fall by a Frenchman named Mascot, and instead of recording the location at once the prospector waited until he received from below an assay of the ore secured, and this only reached him about ten days ago. Mascot at once staked his claim and a week ago Monday went to Selkirk to have it recorded. The telegraph office at Selkirk is not far from the office of record and – nobody knows how it happened – in some way the people at Selwin were advised of the discovery almost as soon as the claim was placed on record.

There was a rush of gold seekers inaugurated not only from Selwin but from Renton road-house and other points along the trail, and before daylight on Tuesday the entire creek had been staked. One of the drivers for the C.D.Co., was one of the first to hear of the new find and at midnight Monday, after mushing from Renton, staked one of the first claims above Mascot’s discovery. By daylight Tuesday 29 claims were staked and as soon thereafter as possible were placed upon record at Selkirk. Mascot had intended to tip the find off to a coterie of his friends as soon as he had recorded his own claim and was much surprised when he returned to the creek and found it looking like a thriving mining camp with two dozen tents put up at intervals along the gulch. Mascot has given out that the gold secured is very rich, going strong at \$18 to the ounce, but has nothing to say as to how much to the pan he secured. He has not as yet reached bedrock, but is well satisfied that he has struck a rich placer claim. The creek has been named Mascot after the discoverer.
