OF HOCKEY JUNK

It's not often a local hockey team has a chance to vie for the Stanley Cup, but it happened one time in Yukon history and the results of the contest make it probable that it will never happen again.

Hockey was big in the Klondike in 1904, and the competition so fierce that local promoters of the sport were looking for bigger and greater challenges. With the typical Yukon "if you're going to go for it, you might as well go for the top" attitude, Dawson organizers wrote to Ottawa challenging the World Champions to a Stanley Cup duel. The challenge was accepted.

The Klondike team sallied forth from Dawson to do battle with the Ottawa Invincibles, also known as "The Silver Seven."

Ottawa Hockey Team Won First Game of Series by Score of 9-2. The Dawson Hockey team went down in overwhelming defeat before the Ottawa Invincibles by a score of 23-2 in the second.

Dawson, Dec. 28 — Mat Tomerlin, who was held over on his preliminary hearing a few weeks ago on a charge of being one of the men that held up the Dominion gambling house here, on the 15th of last November, has made a full confession of his guilt, implicating William Brophy as the "short man," and his partner in the crime.

Immediately after the hold-up Brophy, who was suspicioned as being one of the robbers, was arrested and brought before the court, but on his preliminary examination the evidence was of such slight nature that he was dismissed.

Finding that Brophy could not be held on the charge of robbery another of vagrancy was entered against him, but this also failed, and about three weeks ago he was discharged from custody. He is now supposed to be con-

cealed in some cabin either in this city or on one of the creeks. A reward has been offered for his apprehension.

Tomerlin this morning accompanied the police to where he had hidden his share of the money amounting to \$700 and it was recovered.

In extenuation of his crime, Tomerlin says that just previous to its commission his wife had left him and being broke he was desperate and did not care what chances he took to secure money, but would have killed himself in the gambling room at the time of the hold-up rather than to have harmed any man there had there been any resistance offered.


Having enjoyed all the comforts of home and congenial surroundings at the Whitehorse Inn, a good night's sleep and a hearty breakfast at the Inn Cafe, let's spend the morning visiting the stores and business houses in town, become acquainted at first-hand with the townspeople and visit the points of interest, bearing in mind that this article is offered as a substitute for a personally conducted tour of the town.  
We first visit the local branch of the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce of which Mr. A. E. Hardy is the manager. It was here that Robert Service was employed as a teller and where he wrote his first poems and "Trail of '98", which were to bring him both fame and fortune.  
A portion of the premises on Main Street are now used by Mr. W. E. Emery, the mining recorder for this southern section of the Territory. Next door is the Yukon Taxi where, if

you care to drop in, you may meet Mr. Clyde Wann who operated the first commercial air service in the Yukon. Next in line traveling Westward, is located the Whitehorse Star which from the same location has been serving the community for the past 47 years.  
The Fashion Shoppe is where Mrs. Burke operates a thriving business in serving the needs of the community.  
The ball park, between Third and Fourth Avenue, has been the favourite stomping ground for all sports events for many years past. There also stood at one time, the old community hall operated by the North Star Athletic Association; a veritable landmark if ever there was one. Unfortunately, this edifice was destroyed by fire a few year ago, whilst occupied by the U. S. Army for hospital ....

Telephone Service

The next public improvement to be inaugurated in White Horse will be a telephone system. Already the wires have been strung, the switch boards placed in working order and the receiving instruments will be installed next week. The work now being done is of a private nature, but when completed will in all probability be absorbed and become a part of the Yukon Electrical company.

The system being put in is what is known as the Strowger Automatic Telephone, one of the latest and most up-to-date known, by the use of which absolute secrecy is guaranteed to every patron of the line. Each telephone has an automatic sliding dial by turning so that the figures on the dial correspond to a plate beneath. The sender can be automatically connected with any other instrument on the circuit which he may desire. Should the line be in use, connection cannot be made, a

knowledge of this being conveyed to the one wishing to use the same by a slight buzzing sound.

The Strowger Automatic telephone does away with a receiver at the central office. While a message is being sent the central office is disconnected the same as other phones on the circuit, and there is no danger whatever of any communication which you wish to make being conveyed to disinterested parties.

The Strowger Automatic telephone is rapidly replacing companies in the east where central telephone operators are employed, and there is now being formed in Chicago a company with \$5,000,000 capital to put in the system in that city.

The rules for the telephone will at the commencement be \$10 per month for business houses and \$5 per month for residences.
