#### TORNADO HITS WATSON LAKE

hat has been described as being a phenomena in this part of Canada occurred on Wednesday, September 9 between two and 3:00 p.m. when a tornado formed over Watson lake, raced down the far shore opposite the airport and up the bank to dissipate somewhere in the bush by the tank farm.

The tornado was accompanied by a short but extremely heavy hail storm with some of the stones measuring three-quarters of an inch in diameter.

Pete Koszuk, the only known eye-witness to the forming of the tornado said the water began to swirl and gradually lift off the surface.

Evidence of its violence can be seen on the path it took when it struck the lake shore. Poplar, jack pine and spruce trees varying in height 30 to 70 feet and four to 10 inches in diameter were uprooted and piled together like matches. Fortunately the tornado struck only the lake and the trees.
