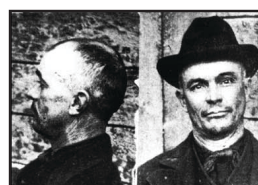

Bouthillette Murderers.**DAWSON - Yesterday Peter
Fournier, who was known to have
left Whitehorse on June 16th in a
small boat with Leon Bouthillette
and Guy Joseph Beaudoin, whose
bullet pierced bodies were found
about a month ago in the Yukon
river near Ogilvie, was arrested
here. Four hundred dollars in
Quebec bank notes were found on
his person. The police are hot on
the trail of a man named LaBelle,
Fournier's partner, and who is
also known to have been one of
the party when it left Whitehorse.A man from Whitehorse has iden-
tified Fournier as being one of the
party of five leaving Whitehorse for
Dawson on June 16th inst.Ed LaBelle, the partner of Peter
Fournier, says that Fournier killed
the men and threw their bodies into
the river while he was absent from
camp on a hunting expedition.



TAKHINI SPRINGS

●●●

Photographer E.J. Hamacher has favoured us with the following description of the Takhini hot springs, the property of Messrs. W.A. Puckett and S.A. Simmons. The springs are distant from Whitehorse about 30 1/2 miles, 14 to the mouth of the Takhini river, 15 miles up that stream to the springs landing and one and a half miles from the river northward to the springs.

The springs are located in a beautiful spot almost level but sloping gently toward the river. The water boils up from a bowl-shaped basin, overflows it at one edge, and runs over the sloping ground until it reaches a deep canyon through which it makes its way toward the river. At the foot of this canyon is a large crescent shaped slough or lake which has an outlet to the river.

The volume of water which flows from the spring would fill a six-inch pipe and its deposits below the springs show large quantities of iron and lime. The temperature of the water is about 120 degrees, Fahrenheit.

The Dawson Hold-Up

Mat Tomerlin Confesses His Guilt and Implicates
Brophy as His Partner in Crime

Dawson, Dec. 28 – Mat Tomerlin, who was held over on his preliminary hearing a few weeks ago on a charge of being one of the men that held up the Dominion gambling house here, on the 15th of last November, has made a full confession of his guilt, implicating William Brophy as the “short man,” and his partner in the crime.

Immediately after the hold-up Brophy, who was suspicioned as being one of the robbers, was arrested and brought before the court, but on his preliminary examination the evidence was of such slight nature that he was dismissed.

Finding that Brophy could not be held on the charge of robbery another of vagrancy was entered against him, but this also failed, and about three weeks ago he was discharged from custody. He is now supposed to be con-

cealed in some cabin either in this city or on one of the creeks. A reward has been offered for his apprehension.

Tomerlin this morning accompanied the police to where he had hidden his share of the money amounting to \$700 and it was recovered.

In extenuation of his crime, Tomerlin says that just previous to its commission his wife had left him and being broke he was desperate and did not care what chances he took to secure money, but would have killed himself in the gambling room at the time of the hold-up rather than to have harmed any man there had there been any resistance offered.
