WIDOW ESCAPES AS FIRE GUTS ARLINGTON

A chance visit by Jim Toohey on his way from his home at Sulphur to Dawson probably saved the life of Mrs. Harry McDonnell Wednesday night when the Arlington Roadhouse burned to the ground. The Arlington is a Dawson landmark 10 miles from town, famous for years for its hospitality.

Toohey had dropped in to see the pioneer widow shortly before she noticed sparks dropping into the living room from the stovepipe safety. The pair rushed upstairs to find the top floor ablaze. Flames shot fiercely through the tinder dry building so quickly Mrs. McDonnell had time only to grab a few dresses and blankets. The fire truck and many volunteers sped to the scene through sixty-below weather from Bear Creek but the old-time roadhouse burned to the ground.

The McDonnell's were Gold Rush pioneers and the Arlington known to hundreds of Yukoners, was built during the Gold Rush days.

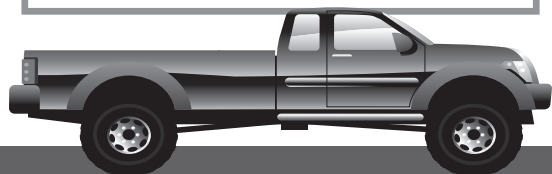

1898 THE DALTON TRAIL

305 Miles from tidewater to the river

Visitors to the Yukon and Alaska are always interested in the history of the areas through which they travel. One of these is the route traversed by the Haines Highway, which follows to some extent "The Dalton Trail" of gold rush days 159 miles from tidewater at Haines, Alaska, to Haines Junction. Mile 1016 on the Alaska Highway in Yukon Territory.
